Throughout the year, we carried out 7 evangelistic missions that yielded a total number of **6,588** lives to Christ out of the **14,073** people who were reached with the Gospel. The ministry completed the year 2023 with **126** staff and out of these members we celebrated **3** church weddings and **9** new born babies to the glory of God. As we reflect on these successes, we are reminded once again that we could never have done this alone. It has only been achieved with the meaningful partnership of our friends from all over the world. More to that, with the transition of Divine Hope from being a Day school to a boarding school, more staff have come on board especially the matrons and Kitchen staff.

We held six staff capacity Building workshops at Divine Hope and Divine Grace with an aim of training and equipping members with professional skills. These training workshops were facilitated by the Director Mummy Phoebe Sozi internally and Mr. Kasozi and Mr. Fagil Mande externally. We thank God for the wisdom He gives us through others.

In the same visit our long time Prayer of having a standard and magnificent office and classroom block was answered at Divine Grace with the commissioning of the Primary Classroom and office block. We give all the Glory to God and appreciate our friends that contributed till completion of this achievement in the second quarter. Special appreciation to the Rehoboth Baptist Church, Jemmy and Jena for supporting these projects in Jesus' name.

In the third quarter of the year 2023, we were blessed by the Dickinson's family (Stephane and Taylor) that mobilized funds to construct a love center in Karamoja at Lokale ECDC which had formally been in a semi-permanent church structure. Education and Sponsorship

a) Early Childhood Development Centers (Love centers) in Karamoja.

1,271 children enrolled at our 6 ECDCs in Karamoja since January 2023.

These are children that would not have had an opportunity to go to school. We are glad that they are not only able to learn literacy, numeracy, personal hygiene and sanitation but they are also being introduced to the word of God. Great appreciation goes to our partners and Friends that always Pray and support these Love Centers to the Glory of God.

c) Divine Hope

The average enrollment at Divine Hope is **266** children at different levels; Kindergarten (Baby, Middle and Top), Primary (Grade1to Grade 7), Creative learning Class (CLC) this is a special class that has a number of children that have been picked from the community after a long period away from school and they are given catch up classes and later enrolled into the main stream for normal learning. From the Creative Learning Class, the children that fail to catch up are enrolled into the skilling class. In the Skilling Class, learners are equipped with craft making, knitting and Tailoring skills among many others. **The table below shows the enrollment of punils at Divine Hope.**

Projects

Savings and credit schemes:

This club started to help women and people from the community who did not think they had the ability to save their own little money and have access to affordable credit. Later through the savings skills training through the DCM staff, they have been able to save and borrow money at affordable credit to develop their families and keep their children in school.

The growing numbers in this project are so exciting. We witnessed an increase in membership. By 30th November, the membership was **365** of which **159** are new members.

We have also witnessed an amazing increase in amounts of savings. For the year 2023, cash realized in savings was **363,220,000** shillings (99,540 dollars).

We thank God for His help in training the community people and the saving culture that is deepening in them and all of us in general.

Women's Skilling & Bible study

The women's project has continued to be consistent with the weekly skilling classes and Bible study. 25 women have been consistent and have participated in Bible studies every Tuesday and tremendous results have been attained since most of these women can now ably stand and share the word of God to others including their families.

We were able to impart skills like crocheting, weaving, sanitary towels making and liquid soap making.

Teenage mothers

The ministry has continued to support the teenage mothers from the community with skilling for instance training them knitting, craft making, weaving and tailoring among others. The current skilling class consists of 12 teen mothers that meet regularly for training. This has helped to restore hope to most of them since they are victims of school drop out as a result of early pregnancies. After completing the skilling classes, they will be able to start small scale business that shall help them to look after themselves.

Spiritual Development

The church has continually increased and grown and many people from the community have been able to nourish their spiritual growth through Bible study, devotions and fellowships.

Children's Church continues to grow through the trainings in creative activities to promote their talents and God given abilities.

The special day (Wednesday) that was dedicated to God is helping so many staff and community members to learn to have quiet time with God, study the bible on their own and have more time for intercession.

A lot of emphasis has been put on evangelism in the neighboring communities and staff members have faithfully continued to reach out once every week.

The sick in the community have also been visited, encouraged, prayed for and some have been supported materially.

Staff members have also been able to organize and visit partnering schools for ministry.

As the ministry we were given two sets of Jesus Film from Life ministry and this has helped us in the spread of the gospel to different areas and this how we have reached out to people with Jesus' film. And this has been used to school, churches and communities.

DISCIPLESHIP

The ministry has continued to carry on Leadership trainings and discipleship classes with the church plant leaders. DCM is still involved in making disciples among groups and communities with particular focus on unreached people groups. For more than 15 years DCM has paved a way to the unreached in several districts.

To date we have engaged the Karamojong in Moroto, Napak, Nabiratuk, Nakapiriti, and Kotido. **36 Churches** have been planted in these districts listed above. We are training leaders to disciple their own people. Every month we train over 40 leaders and hope by the end of year 2025 we will have engaged all the Karamojong people.

We believe in forming teams of leaders that will facilitate and sustain the movement of making disciples who will in turn make other disciples until all people have had the opportunity to hear the gospel.

Divine care ministries organized an annual mission to Karamoja to unreached communities with the Gospel of Christ.

A team of 269 missionaries stormed the land of Karamoja in seven groups reaching out to different communities with the Gospel.

During this mission we had 2 days conference with the youth, and among the topics shared was; salvation, awareness, addiction, culture, sanitation, mind shift, and Career guidance. Throughout the 2 days conference, a total number of **3,221** youth attended and were ministered to out of the 12,778 people that were reached.

Divine Clinic

Ministry still runs a Medical and dental Clinic that serves the school community close to 600 people and the neighboring communities with quality affordable health services like health awareness, dentistry and many more health services from qualified medical doctors, technicians' dentists and nurses.

During the first quarter, a medical camp at the Divine Grace Medical and Dental Clinic was organized and **170** patients attained free optical, dental and general medical attention.

Dental outreach

We were able to carry out a dental outreach to the communities of Divine Grace and Divine Hope and this was led by our beloved friends Dr. Mary Cay, Dr. Michael Koen assisted by Maggie Redpath and Teresa. Part of the Dentists on the team included our children that went through Divine Care and are currently professional Dentists we give back all the Glory to God for such an impact. The reached communities were blessed with dental / Oral health sensitization, dental extractions, dental fillings and also giving free tooth brushes and medication. **657** people were reached in total and we bless the name of the Lord for "the Koens" for funding and supporting this project always.

Farming

A good work has been done on the gardens and plantations at Divine farm and Divine Grace. The harvests are for both food crops and cash crops.

ii) Divine Farm

A lot of harvests have been realized in different kinds of foodstuffs which include; matooke (bananas), maize corn, cassava, sweet potatoes, avocados, jackfruits, guavas, greens, milk etc. All the harvested food has helped to feed people living at the farm including children, staff, vulnerable community members and casual laborers on a daily basis. This farm serves 30 people on a daily basis.

iii) Divine Grace farm;

There were good harvests from the gardens at Divine Grace throughout the year. The crops planted include; beans, maize, sweet potatoes, coffee and matooke.

The project of cows, goats, pigs, chicken and rabbits are doing well. The cows still supply a lot of good milk to the school and the surplus is sold to the community.

We thank the Lord so much that our people at the center have not run out of food and the Lord has blessed our gardens to be fruitful.
